## Minimum requirements:

**WordPress Version** : 5.2.0

**PHP Version** : 7.2.x+

**MySQL Version** : 5.7.x+

## How To Import Divi Layout:-

Steps for importing layout:

1. Open WordPress Dashboard -> Activate Divi Parent Theme->Start By Downloading Zip File and [Xml File](#)
2. Unzip files and you will find one copy of each ie XML File(media.xml, post.xml, project.xml), Layout JSON File, and CSS File.
3. Import post xml / media xml file only in our case under Tools -> Import -> WordPress Import
4. You need to import ' **Media XML** '( There may be 2 or more media xml files in the folder) 2-3 times depending upon server / internet speed till you get the message as shown in the screenshot below.

Remember to update the passwords and roles of imported users.

5. Import Layout (.json) file under Divi -> Divi Library -> Import & Export Button

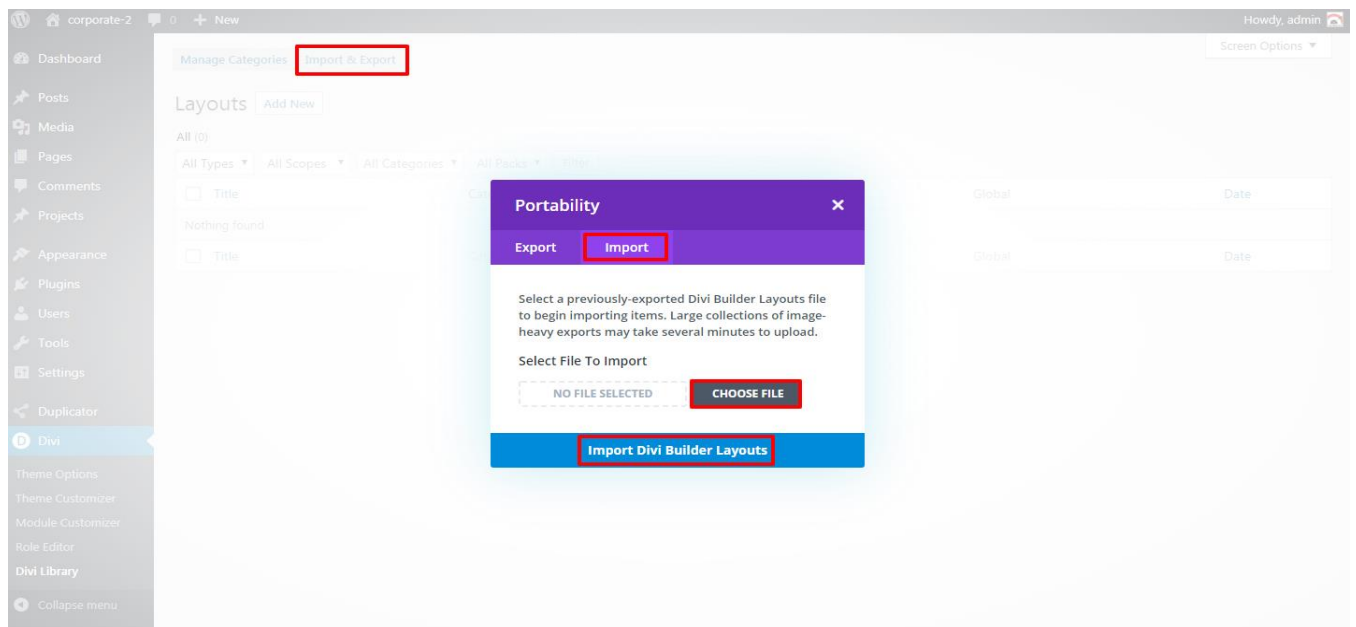
### Further Explanation :-

– For ' **Foodies** ' we have created JSON file for each Page Version / Menu Blurbs that you can import via Page / Library both.

That is you can find 2 folders in Zip folder as A. Library JSON B. Page JSON.

– In Each folder you will find JSON files for each Page Version / Menu Blurb. You need to import one JSON at a time to make it work ie for example if you want to load ' **Blog V1** ' you need import ' **Blog V1 Library.JSON** ' as mentioned in the step 5.

– Similarly you can import all Page Version / Menu Blurb Individually



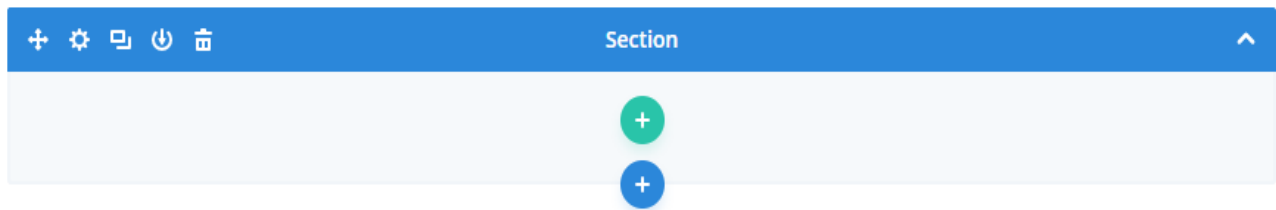
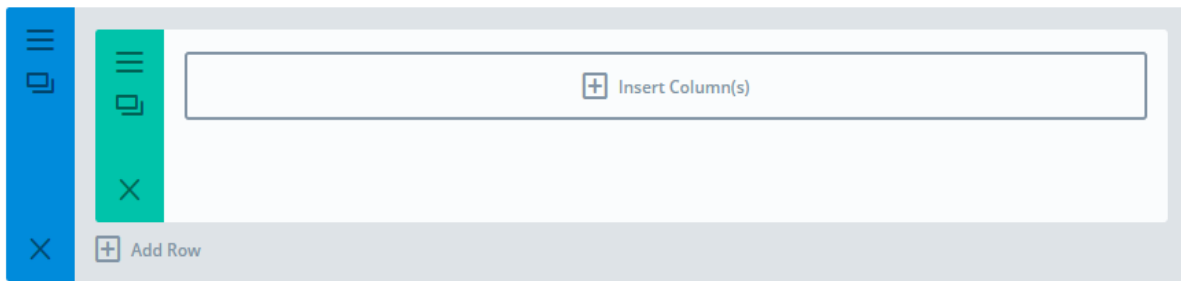
6. After importing JSON files you will see a sbelow:

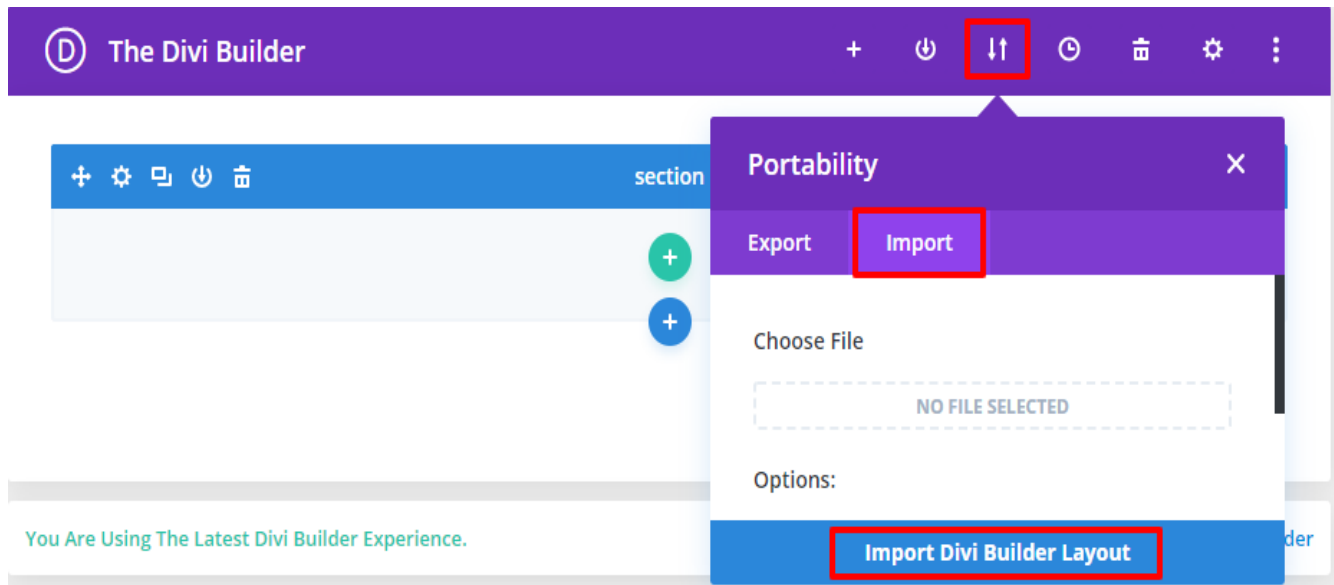
